South Africa is the biggest global producer of mohair, producing approximately 50% of the world's mohair. Most of South Africa's Angora goats are farmed in the Karoo area of the Eastern Cape. Angora goats thrive in the Karoo, with its combination of hot, dry summers, cold winters and semi-desert vegetation. In the pursuit of perfection, their fleece has been refined through consistently high breeding standards and meticulous genetic selection.

Mohair is a versatile and luxurious fibre, offering more than exceptional beauty and luxury. The fibre holds a number of rare, natural qualities which makes it a versatile natural fibre.

RMS Certification


The Responsible Mohair Standard (RMS) is an international, voluntary standard that addresses animal welfare, land management and social welfare on Angora goat farms, and ensures that all processing steps throughout the fibre's chain of custody are certified, from farm to final product.

Individual sites are certified by independent third-party certification bodies using annual audits. Material is tracked from the farms to a final product using transaction certificates, flowing the requirements of Textile Exchange's Content Claim Standard (CCS).
